Frankfurt (Main), 26 March 2018 STRABAG Property and Facility Services GmbH (STRABAG PFS) will perform technical facility management (FM) for multiple locations of Nordex Energy GmbH starting from 1 April 2018. The locations have a total area of around 220,000 m² and comprise administrative and production sites in Hamburg and Rostock. The contract was concluded for three years with an extension option. The parties have agreed to not disclose the volume of the contract.

This was preceded by a Germany-wide call for bids by the wind turbine manufacturer. STRABAG PFS won all three lots for technical facility management, encompassing the head office in Hamburg and the rotor blade and nacelle plants in Rostock. The main tasks include the maintenance of all technical building equipment and 24-hour fault management, as well as caretaker services.

The Nordex Group has an installed wind energy capacity of over 22 GW across more than 25 markets and generated sales of just under EUR 3.1 billion in 2017. The company has around 5,000 employees. Its production network includes plants in Germany, Spain, Brazil, the USA and India. The product range is concentrated on onshore turbines in the 1.5 MW to 4.5 MW class.
