Frankfurt (Main), 11 June 2018 – STRABAG Property and Facility Services GmbH (STRABAG PFS) is further expanding its business with chain store operators. Starting on 1 August 2018, the property and industrial service provider will take on technical facility management for more than 200 stores of the fashion brand ORSAY GmbH.

The contract has been concluded with a term until 31 December 2021 and can be extended by a year twice. The start-up phase has already begun successfully. This was preceded by a nationwide call for bids. Both parties have agreed to not disclose the volume of the contract.

The stores are located in city centres or large shopping centres. Their rental/usable areas vary between 37 and 652 m². The scope of services includes the maintenance, testing and repair of all technical facilities (e.g. air doors, emergency lighting, fire extinguishers, smoke/heat extraction systems, merchandise surveillance systems). In addition, glass and façade cleaning will be performed at some stores.

STRABAG PFS is represented throughout Germany. Chain store business forms part of its growth strategy and is to be expanded further. Technical FM services are performed for chains including O₂ shops, Vodafone shops, Telekom shops and Commerzbank branches.
